



BIRTHDAY TREATS/FOOD ON CAMPUS

The Adelson Educational Campus is a Glatt kosher school. On any given day lunch service may be served from either the meat or dairy kitchen, with a lunch menu posted each week on the school's website. When bringing food on campus, we ask that all food adhere to our kosher guidelines, as well as our allergy sensitivities. This is why all food must be approved by the campus Mashgiach and the school nurse prior to delivery to the classroom.

AT LEAST 24 HOURS IN ADVANCE:











1. Contact the school nurse to verify any food allergies in your child's classroom.
2. Arrange with your child's teacher for appropriate time to deliver.

PRIOR TO DELIVERY:





1. Take food to dining commons for approval by the campus Mashgiach.
2. Take food to nurse's office for an allergy check by the nurse (please note, the nurse arrives at 7:30 am and has limited availability between 11:30-12:30).
